REACH COMPLIANCE CERTIFICATE

Dear Client,

In compliance with Regulation (EC) N° 1907/2006, of the European parliament and the Council of December 18th 2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH), PRECI-DIP SA is considered as a manufacturer of electrical contacts and connectors and acts only as a downstream user and is neither a manufacturer, nor a reseller nor an exporter of substances or preparations that should be considered at risk under the latest rulings.

All substances and preparations used in the manufacture and packaging of products have been reviewed with our suppliers and PRECI-DIP can state that no Prohibited Substances are contained in our products and packaging (annex XVII)

The latest release of Document Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 states the following:

2. Any producer or importer of articles shall notify the Agency, in accordance with paragraph 4 of this Article, if a substance meets the criteria in Article 57 and is identified in accordance with Article 59(1) if both the following conditions are met:(a) the substance is present in those articles in quantities totalling over one tonne per producer or importer per year; (b) the substance is present in those articles above a concentration of 0.1 % weight by weight (w/w).

3. Paragraph 2 shall not apply where the producer or importer can exclude exposure to humans or the environment during normal or reasonably foreseeable conditions of use including disposal. In such cases, the producer or importer shall supply appropriate instructions to the recipient of the article.

While we may ship certain articles in excess of 0.1% lead, paragraph 3 highlights that if we exclude exposure to humans or the environment under normal applications, we only need to supply appropriate instructions to the recipient of the article. As it is impossible to extract the lead from our products in normal applications and the disposal/recycling of electronic components is controlled to avoid risk, we consider our products to conform to the latest regulations as being risk free.

Following the last REACH SVHC January 15th 2019 update (Substance of very high concern list with 197 substances). According to Article 33 of the REACH Regulation, we inform you that, lead (Pb) was added as SVHC substance. As a company based outside the EU, we are required to do as follow:
