



# OEHHA : PROPOSITION 65 WARNINGS

## OEHHA COMPLIANCE CERTIFICATE

Dear Customer,

Proposition 65 requires companies to warn Californians of exposures to carcinogenic chemicals, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be found in products purchased by Californians, at home or at work, or released into the environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposure to these chemicals. The latest Proposal 65 fact sheet dated December 31, 2021 contains around 900 substances.



PRECI-DIP SA products are components placed inside devices and installations and are not accessible to their end users. However, when recycling PRECI-DIP SA products, you may expose yourself to lead, a chemical known to the State of California to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm.
