

China RoHS 2 requires manufacturers to limit the use of hazardous substances in electrical equipment and electronic products (EEP) and to disclose the hazardous substances contained in these products. The regulation has been in effect since July 1, 2016.

China's Ministry of Industry and Information Technology, along with seven other ministries, promulgated the Guidelines for the Restriction of the Use of Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Products (China RoHS) on January 21, 2016. China RoHS 2 expands the scope of China RoHS from Electronic Information Products (EIP) to Electrical and Electronic Products (EEP).

China RoHS 2 restricts the use of the following substances:

- Lead (Pb) and its compounds 0.1%
- Mercury (Hg) and its compounds 0.1%
- Cadmium (Cd) and its compounds 0.01%
- Compounds of hexavalent chromium (Cr+6) 0.1%
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) 0.1%
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDEs) 0.1%

The addition of phthalates is planned for July 2022. We are awaiting confirmation of the implementation

- Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP)
- Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP)
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP)
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP)

We inform you that for the manufacture of our components, we use brass containing more than 0.1% lead, but less than 3.5% lead. Considering China RoHS Annex 2 Exemption 7.3 (Catalogue Exemption List for Restricted Use of Hazardous Substances) we are allowed to do this.

China RoHS 2 restrictions on six hazardous substances comply with EU Directive 2011/65/EU (EU RoHS 2). Since the entry into force of the European RoHS directive, it has become the main standard for product safety and environmental protection.

To protect Chinese consumers and the environment, China RoHS 2 requires manufacturers to restrict the use of hazardous substances in electrical and electronic products and to disclose hazardous substances in their products in accordance with SJ/T 11364 -2014 (marking at restricted use of hazardous substances in electronic and electrical products) and GB/T 26572-2011 (Requirements on concentration limits for certain controlled substances in electrical and electronic products). This regulation has been in effect since July 1, 2016.



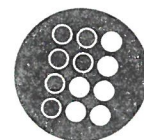
